depending on the level

COURSE **TYPES** (1/5)

"Normal" Courses:

e.g.: "German as a Foreign Language A1.1"

Level A1 / B1: **3** SWS = teaching units per week – 4 ECTS

Level A2 : 4 SWS = teaching units per week – 6 ECTS

Level B2 / C1: 2 SWS = teaching units per week – 3 ECTS

Some courses may be filtered for certain participants

A1: A1.1 – A1.2 **A2**: A2.1 – A2.2 **B1**: B1.1 – B1.2 **B2**: B2.1 – B2.2 **C1**: C1.1 – C1.2

8 weeks 4 - 6 teaching units / week

COURSE

TYPES (2/5)

Compact Courses ("Kompakt"):

same content

same amount of hours in total **But:** shorter duration in weeks

- a) Regular start earlier end
- b) Later start special registration period!!

A1: A1.1 – A1.2 **A2**: A2.1 – A2.2

B1: B1.1 – B1.2 **B2**: B2.1 – B2.2 **C1**: C1.1 – C1.2

6 teaching units / week 8 ECTS

"Plus-Courses"

Cover two half-levels,

e.g.: A 1.1 plus A 1.2

COURSE **TYPES** (3/5)

- Fast progress
- Lots of work

6 SWS = 6 "contact hours" plus same amount of self-study => one whole day per week for learning German

A1: A1.1 – A1.2 **A2**: A2.1 – A2.2

B1: B1.1 – B1.2

B2: B2.1 – B2.2

C1: C1.1 – C1.2
